This event is **Free** to all Boy Scouts, Venturers, Cub Scouts, and Girl Scouts and their parents and leaders.

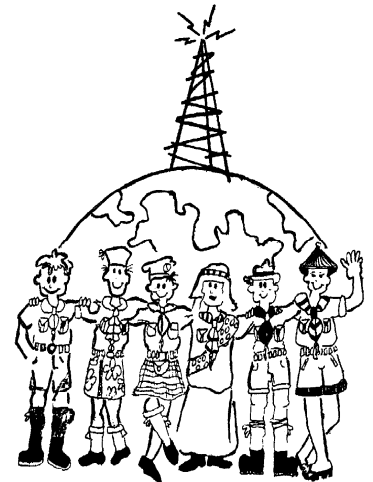
